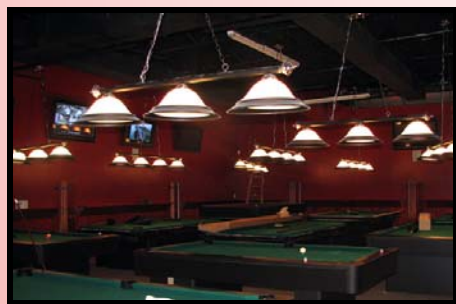

Drive 5 miles north and this will bring you right into Darlington. You will see Applefest parking signs as you enter the village.
